- **Course planning**

- **Registration** – Registration begins Week 3 of the second session every semester. Students must register for the first and second session at the same time. Students with a clinical, financial or other hold will be unable to register until their hold has been cleared. Students wishing to drop, add or withdrawal from a course should contact their academic support advisor.
